**Job Summary:** This employee is a mid-level manager within the agency. The employee reports to the Clinical and Community Health Services Division Director and has the primary duty of providing the oversight of the fiscal, operational, administrative, and human resources management of the multidisciplinary unit and programs in which it supervises, including programs which employ nursing services personnel on varying levels. A significant amount of time in administrative and supervisory responsibilities is anticipated, in addition to coordinating services with other health professionals, community groups and organizations.

The Clinical and Community Health Services mission is to improve the health of the community by focusing on specific groups which are at high risk for poor health, illness, disability or premature death. Clinical and Community Health Services exists to provide comprehensive, preventive-oriented services primarily to those who are medically under-served and who may otherwise be unable to receive these services and also to provide prevention, identification, treatment, education, counseling, reporting, epidemiological investigation and follow-up of communicable diseases for Chatham County residents. Services include screening, education; counseling and direct care, which may be provided in the clinical, home and/or community setting.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Master's in Nursing and three years of Public Health nursing experience (including one year of experience in a supervisory capacity); or graduation from a four-year college or university with a B.S. in Nursing which includes a Public Health Nursing rotation and four years of Public Health nursing experience (including one year of experience in a supervisory capacity); or a Master's in Public Health and graduation from a school of professional nursing and three years of Public Health Nursing experience (including one year of experience in a supervisory capacity); or graduation from a school of professional nursing and five years of professional nursing experience four of which must have been in Public Health (including one year of experience in a supervisory capacity); or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
