RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary purpose of this position is to provide day-to-day management of the Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) Clinic, which includes oversight of the evaluation and reporting of sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) and testing and counseling of persons diagnosed with HIV and syphilis. This position has immediate supervisory responsibilities for all personnel in the STI Clinic areas, including STD and HIV/AIDS. Within this category of clinic management, at least **20%** of time is spent providing medical care to patients as an RN; all under the orders and protocols established and approved by the Durham County Department of Public Health (DCoDPH) Medical Director

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Must possess thorough knowledge of and skill in the application of principles and techniques employed in the field of medicine, nursing, and public health, including communicable diseases and sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). Considerable knowledge of public health nursing supervision of staff and programs. Ability to plan, coordinate, and supervise the work of others.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Master's in Nursing and two years of Public Health nursing experience; or graduation from a four-year college or university with a B.S. in Nursing which includes a Public Health Nursing rotation and three years of Public Health nursing experience; or a Master's in Public Health and graduation from a school of professional nursing and two years of Public Health nursing experience; or graduation from a school of professional nursing and four years of professional nursing experience

including three of which must have been in Public Health ; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
