Granville Vance Public Health is currently recruiting for the position of Social Worker II or Public Health Nurse II, to work in our Care Coordination for Children (CC4C) Department. Preferred experience in Case Management or Pediatrics.

The Social Worker or Registered Nurse in this full-time position will be responsible to identify children eligible for the (CC4C) Care Coordination for Children program. CC4C is an at-risk population management program that serves children from birth to 5 years of age who meet certain risk criteria. The main goals of the program are to improve health outcomes and reduce costs for enrolled children. Each child served by CC4C is linked to a specific Medical Home and CC4C Care Manager. The Care Manager works closely with the local medical practice serving as the child's Medical Home to coordinate roles and responsibilities and ensure the child obtains necessary care. Contacts may occur in multiple settings including the health care provider office, community, or patient's home, as well as by phone. CC4C services will continue until the identified need(s) is met, or until progress in meeting the need is no longer being made. The candidate will also serve on the local Child Fatality Protection Team and other committees and coalitions as appropriate.

Minimum qualifications for a Social Worker II are a bachelor's degree from an accredited school of social work (BSW).

Minimum qualifications for a Public Health Nurse II are graduation from a four-year college or university with a BS degree in Nursing that includes public health nursing rotation and one year of public health nurse experience; or graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing and two years of professional nursing experience including one year in public health; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Must be currently licensed to practice as a registered nurse in North Carolina.
