Nurse Case Manager for Disabled Adults and the Elderly

POSITION SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Provides case management services for disabled Medicaid eligible adults participating in the Community Alternatives program for Disabled Adults (CAP/DA). Performs assessment of patients' needs and coordinates services with an interdisciplinary team of service providers. Develops a service plan within patients' allotted budgets. Makes home visits and visits to community facilities. Communicates with patients, their families, physicians, and service providers.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Experience: 1 year of case management experience in long term care, home care and/or personal care or related work experience. Public Health Nursing experience preferred.

Education: Bachelor's degree or higher in Nursing from an accredited college preferred. If a degree in Nursing was conferred w/o a BSN, employment may be possible with the stipulation the incumbent successfully completes course work and exams for Principles and Practices of Public Health Nursing within a year.

Licenses and Certifications: Current NC License to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) issued by the NC Board of Nursing or another Nurse Licensure Compact State. Valid/current NC or SC driver's license and able to qualify for and maintain a County Operator Permit; Current CPR certification.
