Person County Health Department is accepting applications for the following full-time position:

### PHYSICIAN EXTENDER I

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** Provide high quality care for clients in the Family Planning, Maternal Health, Adult Health, and STD clinics. Perform health histories, physical exams, and education, counseling and treatment services. Manages complete ante partum care of pregnant women independently and renders emergency care if need arises. This clinician is practicing with a physician who is ultimately responsible for the employees' medical practice; supervision from the physician includes a set of mutually agreed upon patient care protocols and medical guidelines with the physician immediately available by telephone, if needed, for consultation. In addition, the employee may also function under the direction of non-medical personnel, i.e., nursing or administration while performing non-medical acts. This position is supervised by the Personal Health Nursing Supervisor.

#### **Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

Thorough knowledge of techniques of interviewing, medical and relevant history taking. Thorough knowledge of laboratory tests and findings; considerable knowledge of available resources and appropriate referral methods. Skills in performing clinical functions and assisting with routine exams. Ability to examine patients and detect abnormalities; ability to record accurately and completely all information necessary to evaluate and plan care and to convey this to the physician; ability to communicate orally; ability to teach and counsel individuals in the areas of health maintenance and preventive medicine. Must possess the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff and to gain the confidence of patients and work effectively with them. Participates as a multi-disciplinary team member.

Regular work hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

**MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE** – Graduation from a Physician Assistant program approved by the N.C. Board of medical Examiners and preferably one year of experience as a Physician Assistant; OR licensed as a Registered Nurse by the N.C. Board of Nursing, graduation from a Nurse Practitioner program approved by the N.C. Joint Subcommittee of the Board of Nursing and Board of Medical Examiners, or graduation from a Master's Degree in Nursing with concentration in Nurse Midwifery Program with one year experience as a Midwife. National certification as a Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, or Nurse Midwife is required.

**Necessary Special Requirements / Qualifications** – Licensed as Nurse Midwife in the State of North Carolina, or Licensed as a Nurse Practitioner in the State of North Carolina.
