Purpose of Position: To provide direction and coordination for nursing services provided through the Prenatal Program. To staff and supervise the prenatal program in accordance with the State and Federal funding requirements. Provide clinical nursing services for clients in Family Planning, BCCCP, Child Health, Immunizations, Communicable Disease, Child Health, and DBC clinics.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Thorough knowledge of and skill in the application of nursing theory, practice, principles, and techniques employed in the field of public health and related programs; for employees in expanded role positions, considerable knowledge of, and skill in obtaining a health history and performing physical examinations sufficient enough to determine if there is any deviation from normal; considerable knowledge of available resources and organizations and the ability to coordinate these as needed; general knowledge of current social and economic problems relating to public health, including health disparities; ability to plan, coordinate, and oversee the work of others; ability to deal tactfully with others and to exercise good judgment in appraising situations and make decisions; ability to work in partnership with patients and with other service providers to elicit needed information and to maintain effective working relationships; ability to record accurately services rendered and to interpret and explain records, reports, and medical instructions; considerable knowledge of and ability to apply the principles and practices of public health; adequate computer skills to allow communication, patient record documentation, and accessing of information.

Minimum Education and Experience: Graduation from a four-year college or university with a B.S. in Nursing which includes a Public Health Nursing rotation and two years of Public Health nursing experience; or a Master's in Public Health and graduation from a school of professional nursing and two years of professional nursing experience; or graduation from a school of professional nursing and three years of professional nursing experience including two years of Public Health nursing experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. **Will accept applications for a PH Nurse II at salary grade 72 (\$56,294-\$88,974) working against a Public Health Nurse III.** Graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing and one year of professional nursing experience. Necessary Special Qualifications: A current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in North Carolina by the North Carolina Board of Nursing. Valid North Carolina driver's license; proof of Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella vaccine or immunity by serological testing as well as any other tests or vaccines required by agency. Immunized against Hepatitis B prior to employment or begin upon employment prior to clinical work.
